### CORECIVIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Thank you for your interest in The Community Foundation of Middle Tennessee's Scholarship Program. The CoreCivic Scholarship is one of more than 100+ different scholarships available to individuals interested in pursuing post-secondary education.

CoreCivic recognizes the potential of its employees and their families, and the company is dedicated to supporting their efforts at personal development. The CoreCivic Scholarship benefits the employees of CoreCivic as they expand their skill set and further their education.

#### ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION INFORMATION

**ELIGIBILITY:** The selection process will balance merit and financial need with an emphasis on financial need. A history of extracurricular and civic participation will be considered. Preference will be given to CoreCivic employees with a record of prior military service. Recipients must attend an accredited junior college, college or university. Students who receive a CoreCivic Scholarship may reapply for successive years of support but such support shall in no way be guaranteed. To be considered, students who are reapplying must have a GPA of no less than 3.0. Students pursuing an undergraduate degree may receive no more than four annual award.

**OPEN DATE:** Application cycle opens mid-December of 2022.

**DUE DATE:** Applications are due no later than February 1, 2023.

**AWARD NOTIFICATION:** Awards are announced no later than late April/early-May.

**AWARD AMOUNT:** Award amounts will vary based on number of applications, amount available for distribution, and school of choice. Last year the average award was \$3,700.

**APPLICATION DETAILS:** The application consists of

- General personal information, such as name, address, family, employment, and income
- The college you plan to attend, your major, any community service and extracurricular activities, if applicable, and the cost of attendance
- Your educational goals through a written essay
- Most recent transcript of grades
- Two recommendations (one academic and one employment/personal)
